




Heard it before?

- Different topics (slightly)

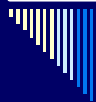
- Same problems!!!!

- Not answering the question – using last year's mark scheme
- Lack of examples
- Lack of technical language
- Giving unnecessary information
- Lack of time planning – paper
- Lack of planning the answer
- Poor English



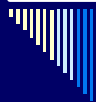
Chief Ex Criticisms

- Over use of bullet points
- Repetition
- Vagueness



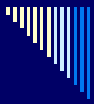
Exam Strategy – It's a Cup Final

- Arrive 30mins early
- Check pens, pencils etc etc.
- Avoid Sixth Form Common Room – Mr Doom & Gloom and Miss Smarty Pants
- Go for a walk – focus
- In the exam room – breathe deep, relaxation techniques



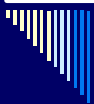
The Ref's blown the whistle - Paper Strategy

- Read all the questions – choice or not?
- Which questions/order? Breathe!!
- Find one you like – do
- Work out time plan – minutes per mark?
- Running out of time – hit them with bullet points



It's a hectic first half – Question Strategy

- Read – **do not write!!!**
- Underline – **do not write!!!**
- Plan – free associate, mind map, list – **do not start writing the answer!!!**
- Breathe
- Now you can start writing the answer – **based on the plan!**

- Do not do interviews with breathless PE teachers
- Do not discuss with mates
