These revision sessions - based on a wealth of experience - help students focus on the strategies and content areas that can best boost their performance in the exam. This is done in a highly constructive and student-friendly way which helps boost students' confidence and enables them to use revision time more effectively depending on individual needs.

The Programme

Each session includes teaching and workshop periods with handouts and lasts up to 50 minutes

Session 1: Top tips for vocabulary revision and acquisition

This session helps students focus on crucial yet often neglected areas of vocabulary and suggests the most effective techniques for extending their lexical repertoire.

Session 2: Top tips for grammar revision and consolidation

This session helps students prioritise in line with exam papers and marking criteria and suggests dynamic ways of revising and applying grammar for maximal gains.

Session 3: Top revision tips for comprehension tasks

Focussing on the trickier task styles, this session shows, for example, how to improve language manipulation technique in order to perform better in tasks that require answering comprehension questions in French.

Session 4: Top revision tips for speaking

This session focuses particularly on techniques for improving fluency and spontaneity in role-play, discussions and conversations. Many of the suggested techniques can also impact positively on written performance.

Session 5: Top revision tips for writing

This session helps students 'pack a punch' in their written work by deconstructing marking criteria and evaluating ready-made answers. It also tackles important areas of syntax such as how to avoid literal translation.

Session 6: Getting your priorities right

This session helps students decide on revision priorities depending on individual needs. It also shows how to apply some of the techniques used in sessions 1-5 to consolidating knowledge of culture and society.

The Programme

Each session includes teaching and workshop periods with handouts and lasts up to 50 minutes

Session 1: Consolidating grammar mastery

This session demonstrates effective ways of retaining grammar via more dynamic techniques. It also helps students prioritise and find short cuts to mastering some of the more complex grammar points.

Session 2: Developing aural skills

Because using past papers does not necessarily improve aural understanding, this session demonstrates alternative ways of practising listening in class and independently.

Session 3: Understanding, rephrasing and summarising

This session helps students retrieve high-level information in comprehension papers and helps them improve their ability to transfer meaning in French in order to gain more marks for quality of language.

Session 4: Improving your translation skills

This session provides advice and activities to help students improve their ability to translate from and into French. In doing so it also builds on session 1 by focussing more on sentence-level grammar.

Session 5: Improving your oral competence

This session focuses particularly on debating skills and on how to develop fluency. It also helps develop interpreting skills and reporting skills - for interpreting scenarios or for discussing a French or English text.

Session 6: Linguistic progression and topic knowledge

This session demonstrates how to build linguistic objectives into consolidating knowledge of culture and society when revising for the exam. It also gives advice for discursive and creative writing tasks.
