## ICT (AS)

# Virtual Revision Conference (course code VR5)

This course covers the key facts for AS level ICT, looking at what students need to learn, typical questions and how they should be answered. The materials prepare students for the ICT1 and ICT2 AS examinations. They explain the theory but also show how ICT is used by looking at straightforward case studies.

### The Programme

Each session includes teaching and workshop periods with handouts and lasts up to 50 minutes

#### Session 1: ICT1 Information

This session is an introduction to the course. It looks at what ICT is, the meaning of information and data, the value of information and the control of information. Capabilities and limitations of ICT are also covered along with the qualities needed to be an ICT professional. It will also look at how to answer examination questions.

#### Session 2: ICT1 The social impact of ICT

This session studies two of the most important topics in the ICT1 specification, the social impact of ICT and the role of communications systems such as the Internet and email.

#### Session 3: ICT1 Legal issues

This session studies legal issues related to ICT. In particular it studies recent laws like the Data Protection Act and the Computer Misuse Act. It also looks at software copyright law, malpractice and Health and Safety legislation.

#### Session 4: ICT2 Hardware

This session studies the hardware of a computer system. In particular it looks at capabilities of hardware, data capture, computer networks, security and backup.

#### Session 5: ICT2 Software 1

This session studies the capabilities of software including operating systems, verification and validation, the use of relational databases

#### Session 6: ICT2 Software 2

This session studies other issues in the specification related to software; modes of operation, dissemination and the Human/Computer Interface

#### Session 4: ICT5 Policy and strategy

This session looks at policy and strategy issues; emulation, backup, software and database management concepts.

#### Session 5: ICT5 Networks

This session will look at issues related to networks, including security, audit and network accounting. It will also cover client/server databases and distributed databases.

#### Session 6: ICT5 Software

This final session will examine the human computer interface, software development, portability of data, protocols and standards. It will also look at essay questions for ICT5.
